Facilitated Dialogues Tuesday, Friday, and Saturdays at 12 and 2 P.M.

- After visiting the exhibition please note that on Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday at 12:00 and 2:00 P.M. the Freedom Center will be holding facilitated dialogue sessions. Please feel free to attend the dialogue sessions. No RSV P's are necessary. The dialogue sessions are free with admission to the Freedom Center.

School Group Experiences:

- The Freedom Center will offer two school group experiences for the Without Sanctuary Exhibition. The first option will allow students to take an abbreviated Resistance tour (1 hour & 45 minutes), and then spend 45 minutes viewing the Without Sanctuary exhibition (including a 15 minute dialogue).
- The second option will allow students to experience a 2 ½ hour exploration of the exhibition, looking into how communities deal with remembering the lynching era. Pre-visit activities are required. - The Freedom Center recommends the exhibition for 8th grade and above. Special permission slips must be signed by student's parents prior to visiting the exhibition. These permission slips are located in the Teacher's Guide. All school group tours must be booked two weeks in advance.
